

LOGIC AND RHETORIC SUPPLY LIST

While there may be some additions from teachers to the below supplies, it should cover the primary student needs.

Language Arts/English – (5th-8th)

- one 1 1/2 inch binder
- five dividers
- package of loose-leaf college rule paper
- 1 package of 100 3 x 5 index cards
- 1 composition journal

Math: (5th-6th)

- (2) Five Star notebooks
- college OR wide ruled
- preferably one subject but it really doesn't matter
- Any spiral bound notebook would be fine IF it's 8 1/2 x 10 1/2 or 11

(1) spiral notebook of any type or size

- Ruler with centimeters
- Protractor
- Compass (6th grade only)

Science (5th-7th)

2 composition books (1 for the fall and 1 for the spring)

5th-8th grade general

1 pencil box that will be used in all classes to include:
pencils, black pens, blue pens, red pens, 1 package of 5 different color highlighters, glue stick or small bottle of glue, scissors, 6-inch ruler to fit in box and 1 package of colored pencils

Science (8th-11th)

Math (8th-11th)

TI-84 Graphing Calculator (will sometimes be used in science and primarily for Pre-Calculus students)

Spiral (with tear away pages and enough for the year) or loose-leaf paper in a binder for both taking notes and assignments to turn in.

Graphing paper – only a small amount and can be printed out when needed.

English and History (8th-11th)

College-rule loose-leaf paper or spiral
